- 25X1 1. On 26 July 1952, the Minesweeping and Coastguard Division of the Sea Police was transferred from Wolgast to Peenemuende and took up quarters at the newly-built barracks installation between the town of Peenemuende and the Peene River, leaving only the administrative offices of the division at its previous quarters in Wolgast. The sea police requisitioned the harbor of the Peenemuende power plant and converted part of it.
- 25X1 2. The division was subordinate to the Hauptverwaltung Seepolizei (Sea Police Main Administration) (HVS) at 139 a Schneller Strasse, Berlin-Niederschoeneweide, and received instruction and orders from this headquarters by telephone, by teletype, or by a courier who came in a sedan once a week.
- 25X1 3. In late September 1952, the Minesweeping and Coastguard Division totaled 680 to 700 officers and enlisted men. The division included the division headquarters, a sweeper flotilla of six motor minesweepers, two Kuestensicherungsabteilungen (coast protection units), each consisting of five coast protection vessels, and the headquarters with the administrative offices at the base of the division in Peenemuende. The division also had 1 tank vessel, 1 supply vessel, 1 fire boat, 2 launches, about 20 cutters, and 1 sailing yacht, in addition to the six sweepers and 10 coast protection boats.¹
4. Seepolizei-Inspektor Friedrich Elchlepp was the division commander and Seepolizeirat Peter Wunderlich the chief of staff.²
5. During the period between late 1952 and early 1953, the division was scheduled to be assigned as escort to the vessel DORSCH which was nearing completion, to turn over to the border police all coast protection boats without crews by early 1953, and to receive in return 18 Minen-Raeum- und Leger-Boote (minelayer-sweepers) (MRL). An order for the construction of these vessels was placed with the Volkswerft Stralsund (Nationalized Shipyard) by the HVS and six of them were to be delivered to the division in late 1952. In early 1953, the division was allegedly to receive from the Soviet navy a former German destroyer and an unknown number of former German minesweepers.³



6. Since August 1952, officers of the division have been saying that the Soviets would hand over a XXI-type submarine to the Sea Police. A request was made in late August for information on division personnel skilled as submariners, torpedo mechanics and gunners.⁴

2. [redacted] Comment. For a list of officers of the minesweeping and coast protection division, see Annex. On 7 October 1952, the insignias of rank of officers and enlisted men were changed to those used by former German naval officers and enlisted men. [redacted]

3. Since the destroyer, the return of which was expected, was said to have a displacement of 1,200 tons, it is possible that the Soviets plan to return the PRIMERNY, the former T33. German boats of this class had a displacement of 1,200 tons. The minesweepers the Soviets will allegedly return may be T 700- class vessels which have been at the Neptun Shipyard frequently since 1949.

[redacted] The XXI-type submarine is not suited for operation in the Baltic because of its large size.


