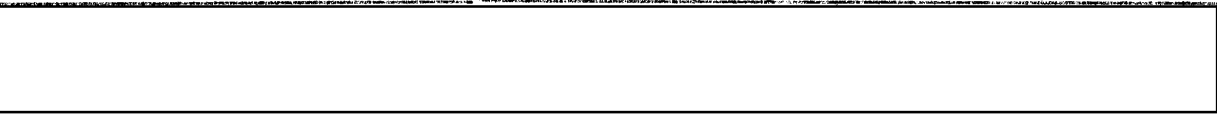

25X1 The present report again indicates that ammunition shipments from the U.S.S.R. to East Germany are at present at an unusually low level, the same observation was also made at the East German border crossing stations.

25X1 Comment. Previously only captured German ammunition was stored in the ammunition depot in Mockrehna. Prior to mid-November 1952, this installation played only a minor role in Soviet supply traffic, but sizable ammunition shipments from the U.S.S.R. suddenly began to arrive there after this date.

25X1 The Mockrehna ammunition depot was also served by Toepchin. It is believed that a total of about 2,000 tons of Soviet ammunition arrived at the depot prior to late November.

25X1 Comment. The dispatch of this shipment to Dannenwalde was reported previously.
