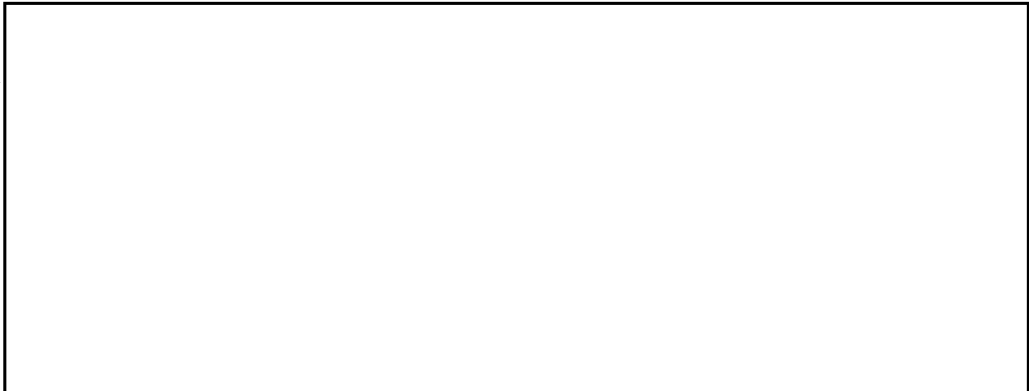

- 25X1 1. Between 19 and 23 December 1952, individual local flights were made by MiG-15s over Wiener Neustadt (O 48/X 34) airfield and over the town during the day and night. Prior to 22 December, the individual take-offs were made at intervals of about 5 minutes and on 23 December at intervals of about 1 minute.
- 25X1 2. On 22 December, a sentry wearing black-bordered blue epaulets was posted at the former officers' candidate school in Bad Fischau. No change was observed in the status and occupation of the installation.



Comment. Wiener Neustadt airfield is occupied by two fighter regiments and a fighter division headquarters.
