- 25X1 1. Between 4 and 5 p.m. on 19 January, guards and soldiers wearing red-bordered black epaulets were observed in the cantonment west of Wiener Neustadt (O 48/X 34). Ten trucks [REDACTED] were parked in the yard. The radar station south of the Wiener Neustadt-Bad Fischau road was unoccupied. Guards wearing black-bordered blue epaulets, and truck [REDACTED] were observed in front of the former Artillerie Kaserne. After some time, the truck occupied by officers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets, moved on.
- 25X1 2. Between 3:50 and 4:45 p.m. on 20 January, 33 MiG-15s, 11 twin-engine planes and 6 single-engine aircraft were observed at the field. There were no clouds. The visibility was good, there was a northwesterly wind of 8 km/h and a scattered cloud base along the mountains at an altitude of about 1,600 meters. There was air activity by MiG-15s which apparently circled over the field. Take-offs were made at 4:12 and 4:15 p.m. and landing at 3:50, 4:05, 4:20, and 4:30 p.m. After 4:15 p.m., the planes were towed by a truck and weapons carrier to the flight control station and parked between the MiG-15s stationed there. The aircraft were being covered with tarpaulins. Two MiG-15s with long cabins approached from south to north over the Wiener Neustadt-Bad Fischau road and then landed at the field. [REDACTED]
- 25X1 [REDACTED] No changes were observed on the AA gun emplacements along Badener Strasse and north of the Wiener Neustadt-Bad Fischau road.

[REDACTED] Comment. Wiener Neustadt airfield is believed to be still occupied by two fighter regiments. A MiG-15 or type-29 plane [REDACTED] is reported for the first time.
