On 10 September 1952 the following products were delivered to the Soviet control commission at the Matyas Rakosi Works:

- 1. 60 hand lathes, model EIN, with 125 mm. center height; 1,200 mm. center distance; gross weight 630 kg.;
- 2. 42 heavy-duty lathes, model EU 175/1,000, with 175 mm. center height, 1,000 mm. distance between centers; gross weight 746 kg.;
- 3. 11 heavy-duty lathes, model MVE 280/2,500, center height 280 mm., distance between centers 2,500 mm., gross weight 4,375 kg.; and
- 4. 3 universal milling machines; model UF; dimensions of table: 1,550 x 415; gross weight 4,150 kg.
