1. D. S. Ratnirov, head of the Russian Acceptance Commission for A-1-p aerial training devices at VEB Carl Zeiss, Jena, left the works with all the Russian members of his commission in early January 1953 after the last of 1952 A-1-p deliveries had been made. It is not known whether Ratnirov and/or his colleagues returned to Russia.
2. The Direction of the Zeiss works expects Ratnirov and the Commission to return sometime in 1953 when the 1953 delivery of A-1-p devices starts.
