25X1A The Partai Islam Indonesia (PII) is a pro-Communist, Mohammedan theist party and has 11,500 paid members. PII headquarters are at Djalan Tembak 15, Bukittinggi, Central Sumatra.

2. The Central Governing Board of the PII is made up of the following:

- Chairman: Hadji Darwis Djambek, <sup>1</sup> Guguh, Bukittinggi.
- First Deputy Chairman: Hadji Mansjur Thalib, Kampung Birujo, Bukittinggi
- Second Deputy Chairman: Datuk Tadjo Sempono
- Acting Chairman: Mrs. Hadji Sjamsijah, wife of Hadji Mansjur Thalib
- Secretary: Mohamad Toha Ma'aruf
- Deputy at Djakarta: Hadji Seradjuddin Abbas, a member of Parliament

3. Hadji Abbas and Datuk Bendoharo framed the pro-Communist line which is followed by the PII; both follow the instructions of Mughtar Lufie.

4. PII members are encouraged to join the Partai Komunis Indonesia (PKI) and Sentral Organisasi Buruh Seluruh Indonesia (SOBSI).
