1. On 2, 3, and 4 March 1953, there was heavy air activity at Parndorf (P 48/X 77) airfield. Groups of four planes took off simultaneously. Flying personnel was quartered at the agricultural school at Bruck an der Leitha (P 49/X 77). The soldiers were trucked to the airfield. Military discipline was good. Leaves were seldom granted.
2. A radar set was observed at the northwestern border of the field. The fuel dump consisted of 12 containers about 6 meters long and 2 meters in diameter and 4 containers about 3 meters long and 2 meters in diameter.
