1. From 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. on 25 March 1953, 38 MiG-15s were observed at Wiener Neustadt (O 48/X 34) airfield. MiG-15s took off individually and in groups of two in fair weather. The six planes parked along Badener Strasse participated in flying. The flights lasted from 30 to 40 minutes. No formation flying was observed.

25X1B 2. There was no change in the status of the AA gun emplacement along Badener Strasse and Wiener Neustadt-Bad Fischau highway. A guard who wore black-bordered blue epaulets and air force officers and soldiers were seen at the flight control station, in front of which truck                      driver with black-bordered blue epaulets, was parked. Five trucks, 2 van-like trucks, 1 "Moskovich"-type truck with box-like superstructures and 1 bus trailer were seen in the garage at the eastern edge of the field. Truck                      driver with black-bordered blue epaulets, was proceeding to the garage. There was no change in the status of the antenna and the PKV-45 DF station north of the field.

25X1B 3. A sentry with black-bordered blue epaulets was seen at the Artillerie Kaserne. There were no changes in the status of the radar sets located in the northeastern and northwestern corner of the barracks installation. Sentries wearing black-bordered blue epaulets were seen in the Nachrichten Kaserne. Six trucks were parked in the yard of the installation, some motor vehicles in the garages. Passenger traffic was light. The former radar emplacement south of Wiener Neustadt-Bad Fischau road was empty.
