- 1. A working-model (Funktionsmuster) of the heiss infantry range-finder (Entfernungsmesser) type 09 has been made at Zeiss, Jena, and indications are that Zeiss will be in series production of the item for the first time since 1945. This device is made on the seissors principle, with a base-line of 90 centimeters. The identity of the purchaser is unknown.
- C. In early March 1953, deiss specialists formerly employed in the conctruction of submarine telescopes met at deiss, Jona. The specialists were mainly assembly specialists (Conteurs) who had mounted such instruments on German submarines during the var. The moting was conducted on the deiss premises by an unidentified Soviet officer. Volunteers for the program were requested, and in answer to a direct question, it was stated that the program would involve personnel moving away from Jona. At least one specialist then declined to join the program. The locale of the planned program is unknown.
- 3. In early January 1953, Meiss shipped six or seven A-1 training devices by rail to levict ITM 23 281 in Strayesberg. This chipment was so made according to instructions of ITM 13695, also in Strayesberg. The devices here to be delivered to a fewiet officer, (fnu) Shurakov or Marakov, of ITM 23 281. In late Earch 1953, being received a time from the last German railways that no such ITM unit was located in Strayesberg and respected further instructions as to disposition of the shipment. Meiss is checking with ITM 13 695 on this matter.
- to daiss, Jena received an order in Larch 1973 from the Last Cerman Lucro fver Lirtschaftsfragen for the following items on a priority basis:
 - a. 150 Yreisrelarimeter
 - b. 100 Tarchen-Prois olarimeter
 - c. 100 bulfrich thotometer, type 17 (used in hospital laboratories)

There items are to be delivered by Teiss directly to the ICM in Berlin.

5. (Pro) From (. D) has taken the place of Er. Locane as chief of the deleg sales department (Leiter Pertrieb). Locane was one of a number of Daise officials arrested on 22 larch 1973 by the last forman authorities.



Fromm was formerly head of the Jena Labor Office; he then joined Zeiss, working in various sections, and became deputy to Woenne. (Fnu) Stanke (SED) is now acting chief of the Zeiss West Zone Bureau, since the arrest on 22 March 1953 of the former chief, (fnu) Buerkerbeil.

6. (Fmu) Heissleben, a spectrochemist normally working on the Zeiss, Jena, premises, is actually responsible to the Office for Coods-Testing (Amt fuer Warenpruefung) in Halle. Heissleben spent four weeks at the Elektrochemisches Kombinat Bitterfeld (EKB) in early 1953 but has since returned to his office at Zeiss. The nature of his assignment at EKB is not known.
