1. Between 28 March and 29 April 1953, 610 boxcars loaded with uranium ore were dispatched to the USSR via Frankfurt/Oder.¹ During the same period, 635 gondola cars loaded with coal from the East entered East Germany via this border station.²

[redacted] 4. On 2 May, a train loaded with 12 T-43 tanks was observed at Muellrose railroad station. The train came from Frankfurt/Oder and was probably dispatched to Jueterbog via Beeskow.⁴

25X1 1. [redacted] Comment. Most of the shipments were reported previously [redacted] covering rail freight traffic through East German border crossing stations. 25X1

25X1 2. [redacted] Comment. Coal imports from Upper Silesia. Most of the coal imported to East Germany is directed via the Gaben, Forst and Horka border crossing stations.

25X1 3. [redacted] Comment. In April 1953, 1872 cars loaded with iron ore arrived from the USSR. A total of 1,535 of them was dispatched to Ziltendorf. [redacted] 25X1

25X1 4. [redacted] Comment. It could not be determined if the tanks were loaded in Frankfurt/Oder or if they just passed through this station en route from the USSR.
