- 87. Technical School. Type of school unknown. New, three-story, stucced brick, 60 x 40 x 12 m., flat roof. No further information.
- 88. Caserne Area. Unknown number of two-story, stuccoed brick buildings, dimensions unknown, slightly pitched roofs. No further information.
- 89. Trade School. Two-story, gray, stuccoed, 60 x 20 x 12 m., slightly pitched roofs.

- 105. Prison. Gray, stuccoed brick, 100 m. square, 10 m. wide, and 25 m. high. Southeast corner of building damaged during World War II and that portion crumbling. No further information.




