1. At 6 p.m. on 7 May 1953, a troop train of 8 to 10 boxcars with personnel and 35 flatcars each carrying a truck was seen at the Erfurt railroad station headed toward Eisenach. [redacted] All trucks were equipped with machine guns mounted on tripods.

2. On 15 May, the two east buildings of the Fuchsberg Kaserne in Justerbo were reoccupied by a signal unit and an engineer unit. [redacted]

[redacted] These reports [redacted] indicate the possibility that the eastern section of the Fuchsberg Kaserne which had been vacated by the 148th Engr Bn (US) of the 1st Gds Mecz Div was reoccupied by the 120th Gds Engr Bn and 145th Gds Sig Bn of the 6th Gds Tank Div.
