2. [Redacted] the East German demonstrations caused reverberations (sic) in Poland. Many families were reported moving east, presumably to avoid violence. The Zgorzelec (East Goerlitz) population has decreased in great numbers.

3. [Redacted] the Polish railroaders were well informed about the East German riots, thought that war was imminent and counted on immediate Western support. Aside from this the situation was normal.
