1. [REDACTED] the Chinese Communist Hainan Military Region (sic) recruited 500 men from each hsien in Hainan in order to increase the local armed forces. The recruits were to receive three months' training, after which they were to be assigned as replacements to military area forces.
    - 2. [REDACTED] four Chinese Communist gunboats and more than 50 armor-plated boats and converted gunboats were in Yulin Harbor. Two submarines were in the harbor [REDACTED]
    - 3. In February defense and antiaircraft gun positions within Yulin Harbor and its vicinity were as follows:
      - a. Six cannons and two antiaircraft guns were at Maling (N 18-19, E 109-19).
      - b. Two antiaircraft guns were at T'ungchingts'un (2729/0064/2625), the site of Command (sic) Headquarters.
      - c. Four cannons and three antiaircraft guns were at Futaot'ai (2421/1497/0669), which is southwest of Sanya Airfield (N 18-16, E 109-30).
      - d. Four cannons were at Yanglanchiaoling (5017/2936/6037/1545) where four ammunition dumps have been established.
      - e. Eight cannons were at Sanyaling (0005/0068/1545).
    - 4. [REDACTED] the Chinese Communists completed the construction of 15 warehouses at Yulin (N 18-13, E 109-34), a construction project that was started during 1952.
    - 5. [REDACTED] the Chinese Communists employed 3,000 workers in expanding T'engch'iao (N 18-23, E 109-43) Airfield [REDACTED]
1. [REDACTED] Comment. There is no information in this office on the T'engch'iao Airfield.
