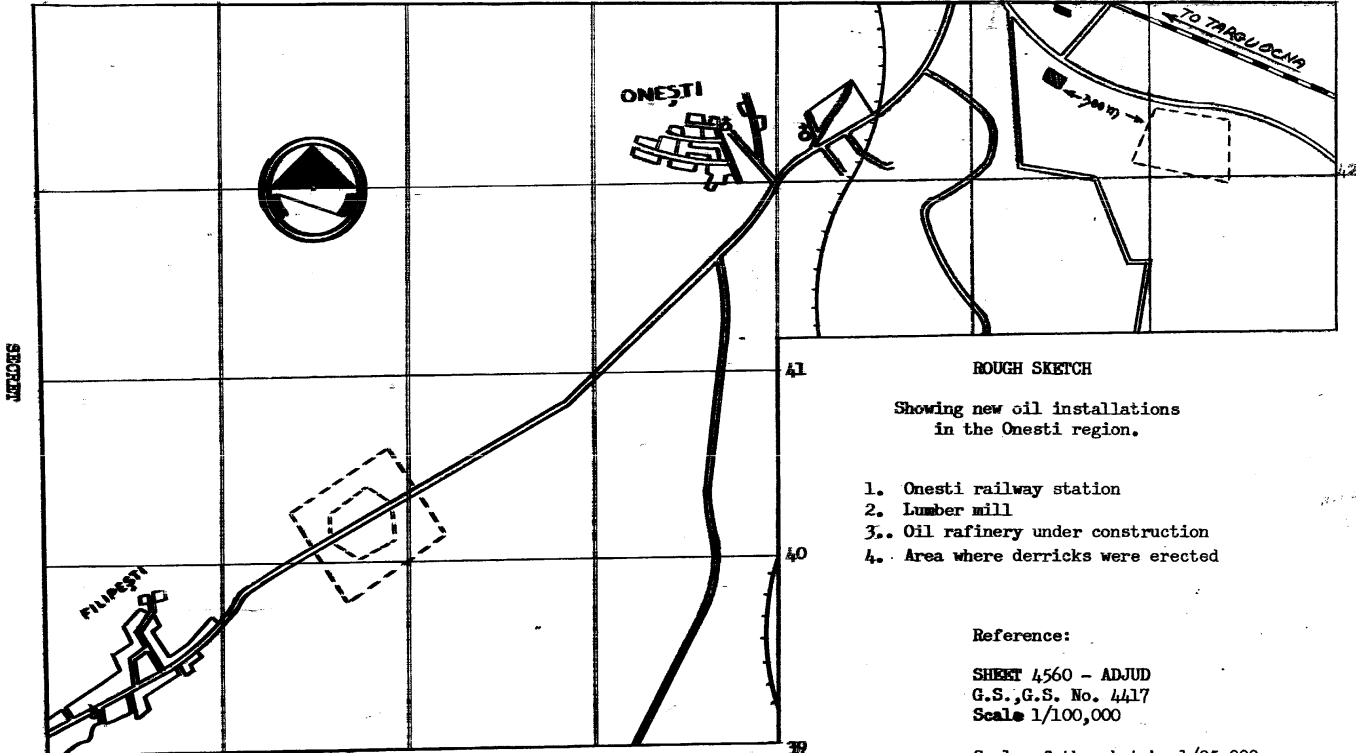
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SOURCE:

1. A fairly large oil refinery was under construction in early 1952 at a site located 300 meters east of the lumber mill opposite the railway station of Onesti.
2. Work groups of the General Directorate of the Labor Service (DGSM - Directia Generala a Serviciului Muncii) were constructing derricks and drilling for oil on a site located approximately six kilometers southwest of Onesti on both sides of the road to Filipesti.
- 25X1 3. new oil wells were drilled in the village of Meinesti where numerous private houses had been requisitioned and peasants evicted from their property and fields. At that time the Rumanian government paid 3,000 new lei for a quarter hectare of nationalized property.
4. Twenty new oil wells were drilled in Slanicul Moldovei during early 1952. Thus, the total number of oil wells in that region is 30.
- 25X1 5. a project which called for oil drills in the region of Targu Ocna. The project also called for the construction of a railroad to link Targu Ocna with Filipesti and Gasin.
6. The Valea Usului Darmanesti oil refinery produced a daily output of 3,000 tons of refined oil products. The products were shipped daily in railroad tank cars. The refinery was supplied with raw oil by four pipes buried 1.50 meters underground. These pipes were 10, 12, 15 and 22 centimeters in diameter. They could be seen at the Trotus River railroad bridge to which they were attached.
