1. Comment. An army ammunition depot and an ordnance repair shop of the Eighth Gds Army are located in Altenhain.
2. Comment. Soviet fuel shipments to military consignees in East Germany, USSR and Poland from East German hydrogenation plants. The figure does not contain export shipments and reparation shipments.
3. Comment. Presumably, troop shipments.
4. Comment. It is known that workshop trucks are constructed in Halle-Ammerdorf.
5. Comment. The concrete slabs are used for the lining of splinter-proof boxes at airfields.
6. Comment. Shipments of runway mats.

Not counting the actual and possible troop shipments, the military supply shipments amounted to 1,553 carloads in December 1952, 1,162 carloads in January 1953, and 2,012 carloads in February 1953. Most of the troops were shipped to the troop training grounds for combat firing practice and to practice marches in February. After the beginning of December 1952, individual troop units of the 8th Gds Mecz Div started leaving for the Koenigsbrueck troop training grounds from the dispatching stations of Ellenburg, Grimma, Wurzen, Taucha and Rueckmarsdorf. They were detrained at the unloading stations of Koenigsbrueck and Schwepnitz. One unit each of the 21st Gds Mecz Div transferred to Lossa and Altengrabow from Halle in January 1953. Other components of the division followed in mid-February, to engage in practice marches of the XXIX Gds Mtz Rifle Corps in the Bad Frankenhausen-Artern area. Elements of the 76th Arty Brig (US) from Merseburg left for combat firing practice in Ohrdruf at the end of January and the beginning of February. Other components of the brigade as well as the 21st Gds Mecz Div left for practice marches in the Artern area in mid-February. Army artillery units of the Eighth Gds Army from Altenburg were transferred to Ohrdruf for combat firing in mid-February. After mid-January, components of the 8th Gds Tank Div were transferred to the Werder-Markendorf troop training grounds for combat firing. They were dispatched via the railroad stations of Jueterbog and Forst Zinna railroad stations. Some of the troop shipments in the present report were previously reported by other sources.

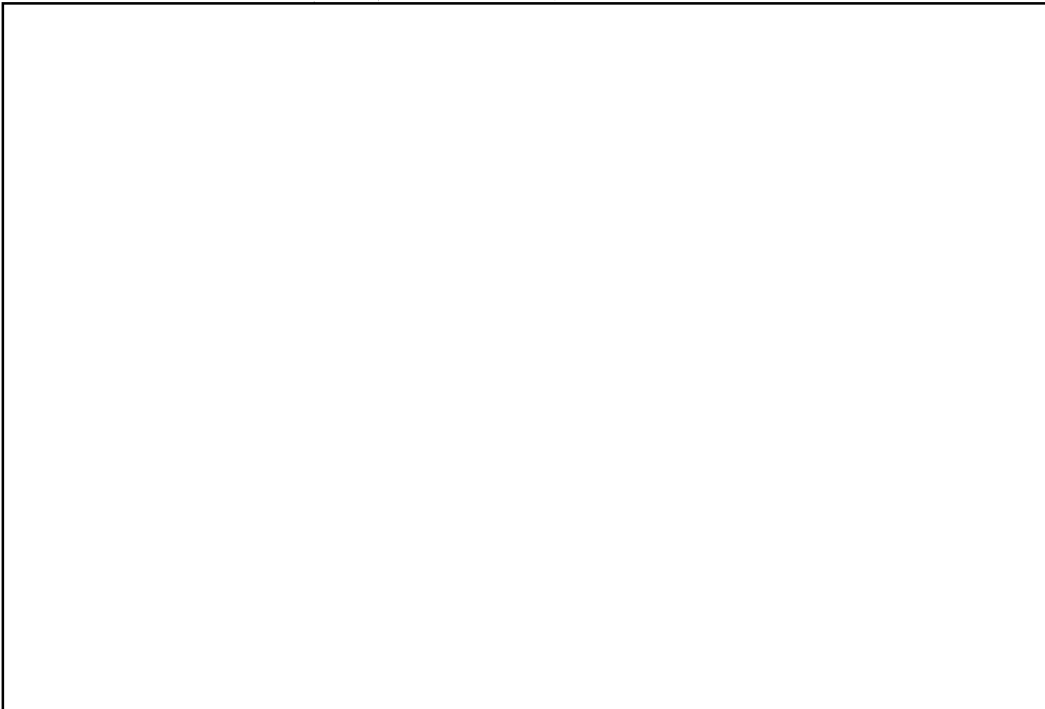
