1. A report by the VVE des Maschinenbaues fuer Nahrungsmittel- und Genussmittel Industrie (VVB for Machine Building for the Food and Luxuries Industry) (Nagemar) in Halle indicated that in addition to the projected plant for the production of 18,000 tons of chlorine per year a second plant of nearly the same size was planned to be erected at the Rokita Works in Dyhernfurth (Brzeg Dolny).
2. Source stated that the Nagemar was executing export orders to Poland and was cooperating with the Konstruktions- und Ingenieur-Buero (Designing and Engineering Office) (KIB) in Leuna.

Comment. The present information indicates that the Poles are intending to execute an old German plan of establishing a chlorine plant in Dyhernfurth. Since the Soviet authorities dismantled the machinery and possibly, also took away the designs, the Poles must order new designs in East Germany.
