- A Russian military airfield is located about two kilometers east of Szprotawa in the triangle formed by the road from Szprotawa (Sprottau) (51 34 N 15 32 E) to Niegoslawice (Waltersdorf) (51 35 N 15 44 E) and the road from Szprotawa to Przemkow (Primkenau) (51 31 N 15 48 E).
- Prom 1948 to 1950 two battalions, each consisting of 81 IL 2 fighter planes, were stationed at the field. In January 1950 one battalion was transferred to Legnica (Liegnitz) (51 12 N 16 32 E) to replace a unit which had been sent to East Germany. In the summer of 1950 the other battalion was transferred to Schoenfeld/Chojnow. Construction work then began on a new concrete runway at the Szorotawa airfield. In January 1951 a battalion of jet planes arrived at the field; it is believed that the battalion was still there as of May 1953.
- 3. In 1953 most of the officers stationed at the airfield lived in new housing complexes located on the road from Szprotawa to Przemkow.
