1. The former section for the production of agricultural machinery at the Vasiova branch of Sovrommetal, near Resita, began production of Soviet type EGW 60-R-2 torpedo motors on 18 February 1953.
2. This is a four-cylinder in line motor of 80 horsepower with a 110 millimeter stroke, 102 millimeter bore, length 870 millimeters, width 390 millimeters, height 720 millimeters, weight 84 kilograms.
3. There are 368 employees working in three shifts. The monthly quota is 65 motors, but only 31 were produced in April 1953 because of shortages of material, especially light metals and chrome-nickel steel.
