25X1 1. In the morning on 14 May 1953, 23 MiG-15s and 1 single-engine monoplane were observed at Zerbst airfield. Fourteen of these planes which were practicing flying during the morning were parked at the southwestern edge of the runway and 4 MiG-15s were parked in the northwestern section of the field. [redacted] there was intensive individual flying, each flight lasting 15 minutes. [redacted] 25X1

25X1 2. [redacted] on 10 June, there was air activity at the field including air-to-ground and air-to-air firing practices. [redacted] 25X1

25X1 [redacted] Besides 8 MiG-15s involved in flying, 31 MiG-15 or U-MiG-15 planes, 2 Yak-11s and 1 Po-2 were parked at the field.

25X1 [redacted] Comment. According to available information, the headquarters of a fighter division and two fighter regiments are stationed at Zerbst airfield. The present report does not indicate a change in this occupation. [redacted] 25X1
