- 25X1 1. [redacted] infantry unit [redacted] under the command of Colonel Pononareus left the Adolf Hitler Kaserne and moved to the Fritzsche Kaserne in Schwerin. Major Polavin (fnu), who arrived from Hungary [redacted] belonged to this unit. 25X1
- 25X1 2. [redacted] the construction of the barracks installations in Schwerin-Buchholz which had been planned for 1953 was postponed.¹
- 25X1 3. [redacted] 2 infantry units which came from the area of Leipzig were quartered at Hagenow airfield [redacted] the field bakery at Hagenow airfield was completed. 25X1
- 25X1 4. The construction of a large boiler house which was scheduled to be equipped with 12 boilers each with a heating area of 48 square meters started on [redacted] The boiler house was to be completed [redacted] 25X1
- 25X1 5. [redacted] the hospital in the Priem forest [redacted] Lieutenant Colonel Griponov (fnu) was chief physician. Major Nikelasky (fnu) was also assigned to the hospital. 25X1
- 25X1 6. Additional permanent structures, each 19 by 44 m and scheduled to serve as store houses, were planned to be erected by Soviet soldiers in Forest Section [redacted] of the Neumuehl Forest near Klein Warin until mid-August. Bauunion Warin and the Grevesmuehlen branch laid normal gauge tracks along two clearings from the Neumuehl forest station [redacted] 25X1
- 25X1 [redacted] Prisoners from the Buetzow penitentiary were employed on this work. 25X1
- 25X1 7. [redacted] projects similar to those in Klein Warin were under way in the area of Vogelsang in the Eberswalde Kreis. 3

1. [Redacted] Comment. [Redacted] the 940th AAA Bn of the 94th Gds Mtz Rifle Div in Schwerin [Redacted] The battalion was believed to have been stationed at the Adolf Hitler Kaserne. A transfer to the Fritsch Kaserne appears possible because AAA had since some time been observed at the installation and the date of [Redacted] in all probability does not coincide with the date of the transfer. Colonel Pononareus (fnu) had been reported [Redacted] as commanding officer of the aforementioned unit [Redacted]
