REMARKS

1. At about 11 a.m. on 7 July, 24 MiG-15s, 2 single-engine planes with radial engines, and 1 Pe-2 which was apparently damaged, were observed at Parndorf (P 48/X 77) airfield. There was a 3/10 overcast, a westerly wind of about 3 km/h and good visibility. Three MiG-15s took off in line abreast formation and another MiG-15 followed after a short time. The aircraft required a distance of about 1,300 meters for taking off. Subsequently, individual MiG-15s took off and landed at large intervals.

2. A small white box, similar to boxes erected at civil meteorological stations, was set up at the foot of the mast of the anemometer at the western edge of the field. Three tents were erected next to the kitchen and messhall. The tent camp previously located about 700 meters east of the railroad station was removed. The construction material sheds were empty. Round timber was being unloaded at Parndorf railroad station. No changes were observed at the other installations. ¹

3. At about 1 p.m. on 7 July, Goetzendorf (P 49/X 57) airfield was not occupied. On the landing field were 4 hay stacks, guarded by Soviet sentries. Five trucks with drivers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets, and loaded with hay moved toward Parndorf. observed at 8 a.m. on the same day coming from Parndorf. The building at Goetzendorf military post which had been used as kitchen and garage was returned to civil authorities by the Soviets. ²

4. At Bruck/Leitha (P 49/X 77) military post, jeep and truck with drivers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets, were parked near the old komendatura. Three officers with blue service color and 1 officer with black-bordered red epaulets were observed entering or leaving the komendatura. ³

- 25X1A 1.  Comment. Farndorf airfield is occupied by a fighter regiment. Excavation and construction work previously reported from the eastern edge of the field has apparently been completed. It has not been determined what was constructed there.

- 25X1A 2.  Comment. Goetzendorf airfield has been vacated since early April 1953. 
- 25X1C  The two airfields at Farndorf and Goetzendorf are possibly administered by the komendatura in Bruck/Leitha.
- 25X1A 3.  Comment. It is known from previous reports that Bruck/Leitha military post is occupied by troops with black-bordered blue epaulets. See
