1. Beginning at 1 p.m. on 20 August 1953, an undetermined number of T-34 tanks and trucks [redacted] and 12 boxcarloads of troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets were entrained at the Gera railroad station. [redacted] the troops had come from the Panzer Kaserne in Tinz. 1

2. Troop trains passing through Falkenberg on 15 and 17 August included:  
15 August. A train carrying 6 AA guns, 5 trucks mounting AA machine guns, 16 to 18 other trucks, [redacted] and including 15 boxcars occupied by troops, coming from the direction of Jueterbog-Altes Lager at 8:20 p.m. and presumably proceeding to Frankfurt/Oder. [redacted]

17 August. A train carrying 8 x 76-mm AA guns, about 21 trucks, including 6 mounting AA machine guns; and 2 field kitchens; including 16 to 18 boxcars, some of which were occupied by troops, coming from the direction of Rosslau at 11:45 a.m. and proceeding toward Dresden-Klotzsche. [redacted]

2. [redacted] Comment. Presumably the train [redacted] which went from Jueterbog to Fuerstenwalde with units of the 63d AAA DIV (US).

3. [redacted] Comment. Presumably the train [redacted] which went from the Wustrow AAA firing range to Dresden-Klotzsche with AAA units of the First Gds Mecz Army.
