Toward the end of May 1953, five army officers and 25 soldiers took up quarters at Nowy Kramsk<sup>1</sup> in the Sulechow (Zuellichau) district, and began to take measurements of the ground in the neighborhood of the village. From the remarks made by one of the officers it would appear that it was intended to build an airfield there.

<sup>1</sup> Comment. On the Legnica Sheet of the 1:500,000 Map of Poland published by the Polish General Staff in 1947 a place named Nowe Kramsko is marked 13 kilometers east-northeast of Sulechow.
