1. The Oder Metal Industry Works<sup>1</sup> (Zaodrzanckie Zaklady Przemyslu Metalowego) located opposite the railroad station at Zielona Gora (Gruenberg) are producing box cars exclusively for the Soviets.
2. The following were observed at this installation:
  - a. On 30 April 1953, 25 fifty-ton box cars with guard cabins and standard gauge chassis were seen.
  - b. On 13 May 1953, 15 similar cars were seen with Cyrillic inscriptions on their sides. These were pushed by Polish workers from the factory premises to the Zielona Gora railroad station.
  - c. On 4 June 1953, 30 of this same type of car were observed coupled together on a railroad siding.
