1. Communists in the Republic of Panama have recently been selling bonds and contribution slips, in support of the finance campaign of the Mexican Communist publication, La Voz de Mexico. So far as is known, only five books containing 100 slips each and valued at 2.50 a piece were sent to Panama. Each slip is numbered and is detachable from a stub on which the contributor's name is entered. All slips and stubs are clearly marked La Voz de Mexico, and contributors are aware that this is a Communist publication.
 2. The campaign, which is limited to Mexico and Panama, is a reciprocal one, in which Communists in Mexico will campaign to support Panamanian Communist publications by obtaining contributions.

25X1A Comment. This campaign is also for the purpose of raising funds for the support of other Communist organs of propaganda such as La Bataille, in France, and El Siglo, in Chile. The directors of this campaign are Maurice Thorez, in France, Manuel TERRAZAS, in Mexico, and one Wilfredo or Wilberto SOLANO, whose nationality is unknown.
