1. On 12 and 14 September 1953, two shipments for the Flak Kaserne, including 37-mm and 85-mm AA guns and motor vehicles [redacted] arrived in Weimar. On 25 September, the installation was occupied by about 1,400 troops. <sup>1</sup>

2. On 27 and 28 September, 18 T-34/85 tanks [redacted] 5 heavy SP guns [redacted] two-axle armored scout cars [redacted] half-track armored personnel carriers [redacted] 4 radio trucks, 30 trucks towing AT guns, presumably 85-mm guns; 22 M-13 rocket launchers, 12 ammunition trucks, 1 ambulance and 5 field kitchens went from Strauch to Raden and Goerzig via Treugeboehla in the area northeast of the Zeithain training grounds. <sup>2</sup>

1. Comment. On 14 September, the trains [redacted] went from the Wustrow AAA firing range to Weimar. [redacted]

2. Comment. [redacted] Exercises of tank units of the 9th Tank Div in the Zeithain area were also observed [redacted]
