1. On 1 October 1953, VEB Yachtwerft, Berlin-Koepenick started producing consumer goods, manufacturing radio tables, broomsticks and similar articles.
2. On 1 November 1953, the Koepenick Yachtwerft detailed 20 workers to Zuckenberg near Angermuende for harvesting, and on 16 November 1953, transferred 23 shipbuilding workers to the Mathias Thesen Shipyard in Wismar, and 13 shipbuilding workers to the Warnow shipyard in Warnemuende. [redacted] shipyard workers would also be transferred to the Volkswerft, Stralsund, and the Neptun Shipyard in Rostock.
