1. The first version of the 1954 Allotment Plan was issued by the State Committee for Material Procurement in June 1953. This version differed little from plans for former years. In particular, it contained allottee 95000 for reparations deliveries, allottee 07000 for the SAG's and allottee 88000 for "various consumers". In the past, allottee 88000 has actually been used for the allotments of the following services: the Ministry of the Interior, the State Secretariat for the Administration of the State Reserve, and the Soviet units in East Germany. After June 1953, the allotment plan was changed. The final version which was worked out by Referat for Methods of Commodity Circulation (Methodik der Warenbewegung) of the State Committee for Material Procurement contains changed regulations with respect to special allottees which have not been published.
2. The following are the special allottees (Sonderbedarftraeger) listed in the final version of the 1954 allotment plan:
 - a. The allottees formerly carried under allottee 88000, plus the Red Cross and reparations, broken down as follows:
 - 1) Special allottee I: Obligatory deliveries (Pflichtlieferungen), which are identical with the former reparations deliveries but will no longer bear this designation;
 - 2) Special allottee II: The Ministry of the Interior and the Red Cross;
 - 3) Special allottee III: The State Secretariat for the Administration of the State Reserve;
 - 4) Special allottee IV: Soviet units in East Germany
 - b. Special allottee 07000: Wismut AG (without SAG's as before).
 - c. Special allottee 82000: the Central Administrations and Organizations (Zentrale Verwaltungen und Organisationen) (ZVO's) such as the State Chancellery, the central offices of the political parties, the German Academy of Sciences, and others.

- d. Special allottee 91000: Export agencies (Ministry for Foreign and Domestic Trade, PII).
3. The special allottees enjoy certain privileges in the procurement of their allotments. In the case of allotments of pharmaceutical-medical supplies to the Wismut AG, for instance, it is known that Wismut AG is not required to record its demands with the Sales Department (Absatzabteilung) of the Ministry (in this case, the Ministry of Health) but can forward a consolidated list of its requirements directly to the DNE office in Chemnitz.
