Sabotage at Power Plant - November 1953

- In November 1953, part of a turbine at the largest thermoelectric plant of Sofia was burned by saboteurs. Since that time, the city has had a notable reduction of electricity and the various quarters receive power only sporadically and in shifts. technicians are expected in Sofia for repairing the damage to the plant. 25X1

Jews in Bulgaria - December 1953

- In 1947, there were approximately 50,000 Jews in Bulgaria. In 1953, all but 3,500 had emigrated to Israel and most of these have requested permission to go to Israel. Three-fourths of those remaining in Bulgaria live in Sofia.
