- 1. In February 1954, RFT Funkwerk Dresden ordered 5,000 oscillation quartzes from VEB Carl Zeiss, Jena. The quartzes are purportedly to be used for wireless telephones to be installed in Machine Tractor Stations throughout East Germany. It is believed, however, that this is not their real purpose, and that they are to be used by East German Police and Armed Forces. Delivery will begin in April 1954.
- 2. The frequencies of the quartzes range from 7.0833 to 13.833 megacycles.
