The Guatemalan Government has moved all inhabitants out of the town of Poctum (Poctum), in the southeast section of the Peten region of Guatemala, on the pretext that there is a lack of water, and Poctum is now guarded, while numerous large boxes have been arriving. I These boxes apparently are being shipped to some point on Lake Isabal, about 55 miles south of Poctum, and from there they are brought to Poctum. 2
