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1. The Power Installations Construction Program for 1954-55 includes the items listed below.¹ These projects have no priority, and it is believed at the Energieprojektierung Department (which is responsible for the detailed planning and supervision of the work) that only Trattendorf I, Zschornowitz and Zittau will be partly in operation by 31 December 1955. The remaining projects are expected to be incorporated in the 1956 and 1957 program.
2. a. Trattendorf I power station.
 Installation of 1 x 25 MW back-pressure turbine (Genscholt)
 Installation of 1 x 50 MW turbine (Wasserschalt)
 Installation of 2 x 160 t/h boilers
 Necessary cables, switches and transformers.
- b. Zschornowitz power station.
 Installation of 2 x 25 MW turbines
 Installation of 4 x 160 t/h boilers
 Necessary water pipes and water filters
 Necessary cables, switchboards, and transformers.
- c. Zittau power station extensions.
 Installation of 2 x 25 t/h boilers
 Installation of 1 x 5 MW tapped turbine (bleeding connection) (Genscholt)
 Installation of 1 x 2 MW back-pressure turbine (Gegendruck)
 Necessary switches
 Extensions to boiler and turbine houses.

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d. Pirna power station.

Installation of 5 x 80 t/h boilers
Installation of 5 x 12.5 MW turbines
Construction of turbine house and foundations for turbines.

e. Karl-Marx-Stadt (Muellerstrasse) power station extensions.

Installation of 4 x 80 t/h boilers
Installation of 2 x 25 MW or 1 x 31.5 MW turbines
Necessary switches and extensions to boiler house
Necessary extensions to turbine house, once the type of turbine has been decided.

f. Berzdorf power station:

Installation of 12 x 160 t/h boilers
Installation of 6 x 25 MW back pressure turbines (Model 1*)
Installation of 6 x 50 MW turbines (Model 1*)
New construction of boiler and turbine houses.

g. It has been decided to alter or modify the following, but no plans have yet been drawn up:

- Extensions to Dresden power station
- Extensions to Dresden-Johannstadt power station
- Extensions to Karl-Marx-Stadt old power station
- Generators for pump-fed power station Amalienhoehe²

1. Comment: some of the plans are very ambitious (for example, Berzdorf) and completion will drag on to 1956 - 1957, if not later.

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2. Comment: Possibly Amalienhof.

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
