[Redacted] while a southwesterly wind was blowing with a force of fresh to strong and the sky was overcast, Soviet auxiliary vessel [Redacted] and a smaller vessel [Redacted] were sighted near buoy No. 5 on the prescribed channel No. 55 in the Baltic Sea. The two ships steered a southwesterly course coming from a northeasterly direction.
