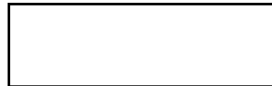

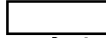

Comment.

The Alen fuel depot of the Twenty-Fourth Army had the following supply traffic during the first quarter of 1954:

	<u>Incoming</u>	<u>Outgoing</u>
January	93 tank cars with 1,755 metric tons	98 tank cars with 1,830 metric tons
February	70 tank cars with 1,350 metric tons	56 tank cars, with 1,020 metric tons
March	105 carloads with 1,788 metric tons	143 tank cars with 2,760 metric tons

The amount of incoming and outgoing fuel is somewhat below the average amount of 1953. No conclusions can be drawn, however, since some fuel is being shipped to the airfields directly from the production plants.
