1. Artillery Division at Szeged.

a. The artillery division at Szeged [REDACTED] was set up in the spring of 1953. It is located in the Tancsics Mihaly artillery barracks on Bartok Street in Szeged. 25X1

b. The division has the following regiments: 25X1

1.) Motorized Artillery Regiment [REDACTED] is stationed in the same barracks mentioned above. After the 1953 maneuvers, the regiment was reorganized and now it has only two groups:

(a) 1 Artillery Group, consisting of three batteries, each armed with four 122-mm. guns;

(b) 2 Artillery Group, consisting of three batteries, each armed with four 152-mm. guns;

(c) The regiment also has the following vehicles:

- 12 track-laying tractors (trattori cingolati) of the DT-413 type
- 15 weapon carriers
- 6 GAZ-51 trucks
- 8 Csepel-Diesel trucks
- 1 tank truck
- 1 mobile shop

2.) Field Artillery Regiment [REDACTED] is stationed in Veszprem in the Jutas Barracks. Organization and armament of the regiment is as follows: 25X1

(a) 1 Group; three batteries, each armed with four 76.2-mm. field guns;

- (d) The motorized equipment of the regiment consists of:

 1 mobile shop
 1 tank truck
 2 automobiles
 3 jeeps
 1 ambulance
 10 motorcycles

- 3.) Heavy Mortar Regiment [] is located in the new barracks at Hodmezovasarhely. The organization and armament of the regiment is as follows:

- (a) 1 Group: armed with twelve 82-mm. pieces
- (b) 2 Group: armed with twelve 120-mm. mortars
- (c) 3 Group: same with twelve 120-mm. mortars.
- (d) The motorized equipment of the regiment consists of:

24 weapon carriers
 15 GAZ-51 trucks
 12 Csepel-Diesel trucks
 5 jeeps
 1 mobile shop
 1 ambulance
 1 tank truck
 8 motorcycles

2. Mortar Regiment, []

It was organized in Pápa in 1949. From Pápa it was transferred to Veszprém and then to Komárom. It is subordinate to the 9 Infantry Division of Veszprém. The headquarters and the various units of the regiment are stationed as of January 1954 in the Ujtúzer barracks of Komárom. The regiment is made up of the two groups, each consisting of three batteries; each battery is armed with four 120-mm. pieces. The motorized equipment of the regiment is made up of the following:

12 GMC prime movers
 15 weapon carriers
 8 Csepel-Diesel trucks
 4 jeeps
 1 mobile shop
 1 tank truck
 2 motorcycles

3. Artillery Regiment, []

- a. It was set up in the spring of 1953 and belongs to the 9 Infantry Division of Veszprém. The headquarters of the regiment, together with the 1 and 2 Groups, is located in Erying (Y5D97), while the 3 Group is stationed in Lepsény (Y5 D97).

b. Organization and armament of the groups:

- 1 Group; three batteries, each armed with four Model 50 guns of 76.2 mm. caliber.
- 2 and 3 Groups; with three batteries each; each battery is armed with four 122-mm. guns.
4. In Balatonfured (Y5D66) there is a mortar regiment.
5. Artillery Regiment,  of Veszprém, originally belonged to the 9 Infantry Division of Veszprém.
6. Headquarters of the 5 Infantry Division, formerly located in Kaposvár, has been transferred to Nagykanizsa.
