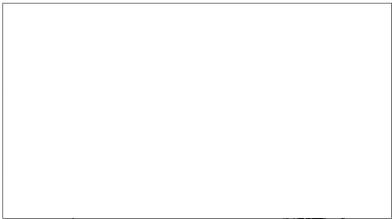

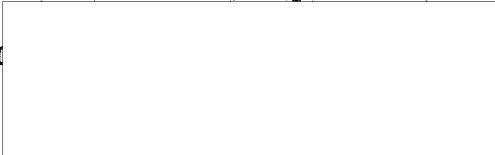

- 2. Ing. Wilhelm Stumpf was transferred together with Lembke to Department TEE, where he is also engaged in work on the large station receiver.
- 3. Ing. Alfred Schneider, also formerly with Department TEU, was transferred to Department TEE together with Lembke and was charged with the supervision of the development of a goniometer location finder.
