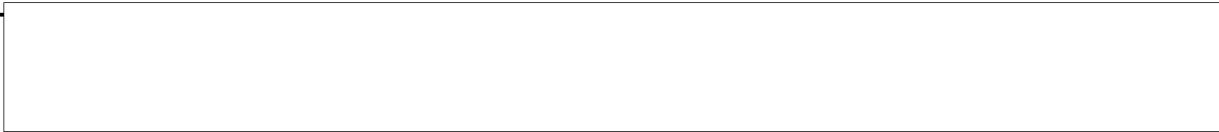

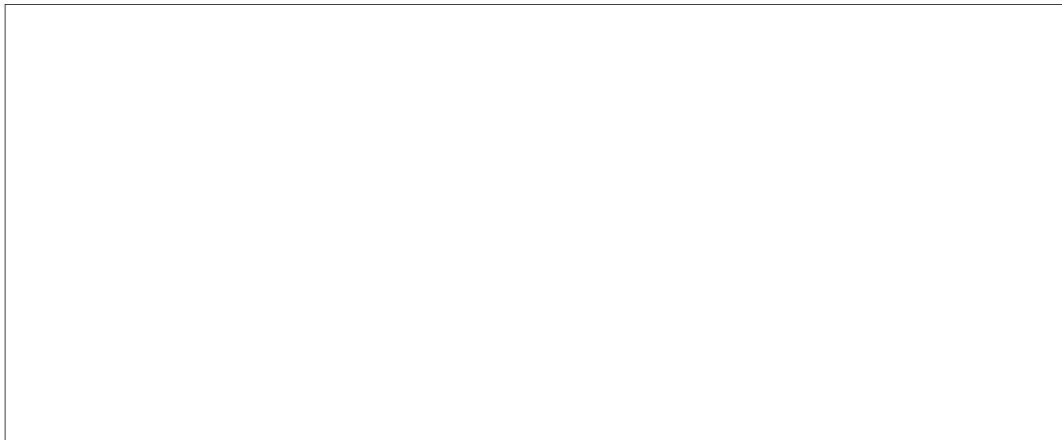

1. As of March 1954, eighty percent of the production of wolfram in Kwangtung Province was being sent to the USSR.¹ The remaining twenty percent was being exchanged by the authorities for strategic material. 25X1
2. At the end of February, 290 young men, newly graduated from the Technical School at Canton, were sent to North China.² They are to be employed in various chemical factories at Shanghai, Tientsin, Mukden, and Hsian (N 34-16, E 108-54).
