2. During the period from 15 to 30 March 1954, the instruction course for maritime surveying engineers held at the Schwedenschanze barracks installation was terminated. About 20 students passed the examination and were promoted to the rank of Unterleutnant.

1. [ ] Comment. Most of the vessels mentioned are fishing craft or motor launches. The number of vessels available is far in excess of the number formerly employed for surveying tasks and work on the buoyage and lighthouse system in this area. The employment of many small vessels for surveying tasks in these waters seems to be a good plan; on the other hand many of the vessels mentioned in the above list seem to be too small to guarantee independent and accurate work, even in calm weather. There is reason to believe that some of these vessels are used only for minor tasks.
