Almost every day between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. during the period from 17 to 25 April 1954, a swept-back jet aircraft was observed flying over Gdynia (Q 55/34-U; CF 4143) harbor at an altitude of about 3,000 meters and at intervals of half an hour. [redacted] the aircraft which always approached from the southeast at a high speed. The aircraft headed northwest and over the Baltic Sea turned and then departed toward the southeast. The aircraft apparently did not come from Babie Doly airfield which is located near Gdynia. 25X1

[redacted] Comment. The direction of approach and departure of the jet aircraft observed indicates that the aircraft probably came from Marienburg airfield which is occupied by Polish fighter units. 25X1
