- Between 0800 and 1400 on 24 July 1954, the following aircraft were observed at Aspern airfield: 28 MiG-15s, 3 Yak-11s, 2 Li-2s, and 2 biplanes. There was a 8/10 overcast at an altitude of about 1,500 meters, a southwesterly wind of about 10 km/h, and good visibility. No air activity was being conducted. Individual personnel were seen near the MiG-15 dispersal areas at the western edge of the field. A Stalin-type tractor towing a roller moved on the landing field. Vehicular traffic observed near the flight control building involved fire truck [REDACTED] trucks [REDACTED] and tank truck [REDACTED] all with drivers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets. The following motor vehicles were parked in the sheds and in the open near the garages:  
18 motor vehicles whose types could not be identified,  
2 trucks [REDACTED] 4 tank trucks, and 2 trailers. Five tank trucks were parked in the area of the western fuel dump. The AA gun emplacements were not occupied.
- The buildings in Aspern military post which had formerly been occupied by the Soviets were vacated. Vehicular traffic involved trucks [REDACTED] and weapon-carrier [REDACTED] all with drivers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets.
- Two sedans were parked in the yard of the Conrad Kaserne in Gross Enzersdorf (48°12' N/16°33' E) military post. Truck [REDACTED] with driver wearing black-bordered blue epaulets moved into the barracks installation coming from the direction of Aspern. The following motor vehicles were parked in the yard of the former home for aged people at No 156 on Kasernen Strasse:  
8 trucks [REDACTED]  
5 van-like trucks [REDACTED]  
and 2 trucks mounting searchlights [REDACTED]  
Vehicular traffic involved truck [REDACTED] and van-like truck [REDACTED] with drivers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets.

Comment. Aspern airfield is believed to be still occupied by a Soviet fighter regiment. Only a few buildings in Aspern had previously been occupied by Soviet Air

Force personnel. It is assumed that the personnel and offices previously quartered there have meanwhile been moved into the other quartering buildings of the field. It is not believed that the personnel strength was reduced.
