On 7 July 1954, no aircraft were observed at Buchholz airfield. The landing field had a thin grass cover. [redacted] a building housing the guard personnel was located at the northern edge of the field. Some sheds were allegedly located east of the building and that occasionally, an obsolete aircraft landed at the field.

[redacted] Comment: In 1952, a 20-cm layer of sod was raised on a take-off and landing strip at Buchholz airfield which covers an area of about 2,800 x 500 meters. No installations exist at the field. No information has been received as to the serviceability of the field area.
