REMARKS

This is UNEVALUATED Information

1. Between 0830 and 1530 on 11 August 1954, 46 MiG-15s, 3 Yak-11s, 1 Li-2 and 2 biplanes were observed at Wiener Neustadt airfield. There was a 10/10 overcast with intermittent rain showers up to 1030, subsequently a ceiling of up to 6/10, a westerly wind of about 15 km/h, and an average visibility range of about 1 km. No air activity was observed. Vehicular traffic at the flight control station involved van-like trucks [redacted] trucks Nos [redacted] all with drivers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets, and jeep [redacted]. The following motor vehicles were parked in the area of the eastern garage: 2 Stalin-type tractors, 4 van-like trucks, 6 trucks, and 1 command bus. Tank truck [redacted] with driver wearing black-bordered blue epaulets moved into the installation. About 100 meters southwest of the garages was a radar set with antennas shaped like an "X".² Three soldiers were working on the motor vehicle. The southern and eastern AA gun emplacements were not occupied. MiG-15 crates and auxiliary fuel tanks all of which were damaged were stored near the sheds in the area of the pyrotechnic plant. 25X1

2. The Artillerie Kaserne in the Wiener Neustadt military post was guarded by sentries wearing black-bordered blue epaulets. Three van-like trucks and 6 trucks were parked in the barracks yard. Motor vehicles seen entering and leaving the installation included sedan No B 4-59-25, jeep [redacted] and trucks [redacted] the latter two with drivers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets. Two van-like trucks, 3 trucks and 1 tank truck were parked in the yard of the Nachrichten Kaserne which was guarded by soldiers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets. Vehicular traffic to and from the installation involved trucks [redacted] and jeep [redacted] the latter two with drivers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets. 25X1

1. [redacted] Comment. It is believed that Wiener Neustadt airfield is occupied by 2 fighter regiments and the superior division headquarters. 25X1

2. [redacted] Comment. From sketches, it is inferred that the set is a model AA 4 Mk I.I radar set. The set possibly belongs to the AA unit stationed at the airfield. 25X1
