REMARKS _____

This is UNEVALUATED Information

1. Between 0830 and 1600 on 20 August 1954, 48 MiG-15s, 3 Yak-11s and 1 Li-2 were observed at Wiener Neustadt airfield. 1 MiG-15s and Yak-11s practiced flying. There was a 6/10 overcast at an altitude of about 2,000 meters and good visibility. Take-offs and landings were made in southeast-northwest direction. After landing, the aircraft taxied to the take-off point at the edge of the woods, southeast of the pyrotechnics plant. No firing at air sleeves was observed. The following take-offs and landings were seen:

During air activity, the following motor vehicles were seen proceeding toward the field or shuttling between the flight control station and the take-off points: Trucks

Except for tank truck the driver wore black-bordered blue epaulets. Truck with driver wearing black-bordered blue epaulets parked in front of the flight control station. Three van-like trucks, 5 trucks, 3 Stalin-prime movers, and 1 Loshkovich-type truck were parked in the area of the eastern garage installation. Trucks both of them with drivers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets entered and left the installation. The southern and eastern AA gun emplacements were unoccupied. Six trucks were parked at the northern temporary buildings.

2. Four trucks, 2 van-like trucks, 3 jeeps, and 1 sedan were parked in the yard of the Artillerie Kaserne in Wiener Neustadt. Trucks and van-like truck all of them with drivers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets were identified in traffic. Six trucks and 2 van-like trucks were parked in the yard of the Nachrichten Kaserne.

3. At the Theresienfeld airfield and repair shop, 1 MIG-15 was seen parked in a hangar and 1 biplane in front of the hangar. Five van-like trucks and 3 trucks were seen in the parking lot.

1. Comment. Two Soviet fighter regiments and the superior division headquarters are stationed at Wiener Neustadt airfield.

2. Comment. Aircraft were already previously observed at Wiener Neustadt; was observed in Parndorf on 6 August 1954; is reported for the first time in Austria.
