REMARKS	This is UNEVALUATED Information		

1. Between 1530 and 1700 on 20 July 1954, no aircraft were parked at Zwoelfaxing airfield nor was any activity being conducted there. The Fishnet-type and Token-type radar sets were not in operation. Two men were observed in the area of the barracks buildings and one officer wearing blue-bordered blue epaulets left the barracks installation and proceeded toward Schwechat (48°03'N/16°28'E). A few officers and EM wearing black-bordered blue epaulets were observed in Altkettenhof of Schwechat military post which was guarded by sentries who also wore black-bordered blue epaulets. The previously reported umbrella-type antenna was still observed in the installation. 25X1

2. On 21 July, no aircraft or any activity was observed at the field. The van-like truck northeast of the Token-type radar set was removed. No personnel or vehicular traffic was observed in the barracks area. Seven motor vehicles were counted in the garages of Altkettenhof in Schwechat military post. There was no personnel or vehicular traffic.

Comment. The radar station consisting of a Token-type set and a Fishnet-type set was previously reported from Zwoelfaxing airfield. It is possibly assigned to the fighter division in Wiener Neustadt.
