1. In response to the signing of the Balkan pact, the Soviets have allegedly considered occupation of strategic places in Bulgaria.

Rumanian Cavalry Troops in Bulgaria

2. Elements of Rumanian cavalry troops, equipped with unidentified artillery pieces, were observed 15 kilometers north of Stalin, possibly for joint Bulgarian-Rumanian maneuvers.
