At about 1600 hours on 24 July 1954, a group of eight Soviet naval vessels was observed proceeding from Tallinn to Porkkala in the Gulf of Finland. They sailed in line formation 200 to 300 meters apart. Six of the vessels were of the T-301 type.

[REDACTED] The rear two units of the group were KRONSTADT-Class vessels with an open stepped bridge.
