1. Between 0700 and 1400 on 4 September 1954, 46 MiG-15s, 1 Il-28, 3 Yak-11s, and 1 biplane were parked at Wiener Neustadt airfield. No flying activity was observed. There was a 0/10 overcast, westerly wind of 25 km/h and good visibility.¹ One of the two hard-stands, each of which will hold 8 MiG-15s, on Badener Strasse had been completed while the other was still under construction. Twenty-five men wearing black-bordered blue epaulets were seen doing leveling work with a roller which was towed by a Stalin tractor. The completed hard-stand was occupied by 8 MiG-15s. Alongside of each Mig-15, 1 small ladder, an auxiliary fuel tank and a small box were seen. The fence sections at the eastern and southern boundaries of the field had been completed. An antenna mast with 4 tents next to it was observed southwest of the motor vehicle shed. The mast was previously seen at its present location but in the meantime had been removed. Civilians were engaged in construction work at the damaged building near the flight control station. Eight trucks, 2 tank trucks, 1 trailer of a mobile flight control station, and 3 Stalin tractors were parked in the sheds of the eastern garage installation. Van-like truck [REDACTED] with driver wearing black-bordered blue epaulets entered the installation. 25X1
2. Three partly dismantled MiG-15s were seen in the hangar at Theresienfeld airfield. One biplane and 18 gray crates were seen in front of the hangar. Truck [REDACTED] with driver wearing black-bordered blue epaulets coming from the direction of Sollenau entered the installation. The truck was loaded with sawdust and two crates. It was not determined whether the sawdust was loaded as shock-absorbing material for the two crates or whether a shipment of packing material for the Theresienfeld aircraft repair shop was concerned.² 25X1
3. Three trucks, 4 van-like trucks and 1 sedan were parked in the yard of the Artillerie Kaserne. Trucks [REDACTED] and van-like truck [REDACTED] all of them with drivers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets and sedan [REDACTED] left the installation. The antennas in the yard of the barracks installation were still at their previous locations. A long-wire antenna had been erected on the roof of the center building. Truck [REDACTED] and 2 jeeps were parked in the garage shed of the Nachrichten Kaserne. 25X1
