1. At 1500 on 1 October, the AAA camp Apetlon was vacated except for a guard detail. The various roads and lanes were again open to traffic. The guard detail was quartered in the former custom houses on the northwestern perimeter of Apetlon. Five motor vehicles were parked near these buildings. The bus garage of the Austrian State Railways was confiscated. The garage, however, has not yet been occupied. Prior to 0600 on 30 September, the AAA camp was still occupied.

Bruck/Leitha

2. At 0500 on 1 October, a troop train of 25 boxcars with soldiers and an undetermined number of flatcars with 8 AA guns and 2 field kitchens passed through the Bruck on the Leitha River railroad station. The train came from Wallern and went to Korneuburg. Two additional troop with AA guns from Wallern were scheduled to pass through Bruck. Their destination could not be determined.

Comment. The present report indicates that the AAA units which held field exercises or AAA firing practices at the Apetlon AAA Range left Apetlon by late September 1954.  The confiscation of the bus garage during the fall of 1954 was previously reported. The procedure possibly is connected with an alleged occupation of a section of the camp during the winter of 1954/1955.  The troop train with AA guns from Wallern to Korneuburg carried units of the 23d AAA Div back to their winter quarters.
